

How to Make Sure Your Tow Operator Is Legit



If you've been in an accident and your car is disabled, take these precautions to protect yourself from inflated expenses and complications:

- 1 Make sure your tow operator was dispatched** by the police.
- 2 Ask for identification** like a business card with company name, address and phone number, then provide your insurance company with the information.
- 3 Write down the tow truck's license plate number** or take photos of any identifying information on it.
- 4 Don't sign any towing slip** unless fees have been filled in!
- 5 If police have not responded to your accident** or if the tower has not provided the info you've requested, call 911 and tell them you're not comfortable with the tower and ask them for assistance at your location.
